Suspend 27.8 grams in 1000 ml distilled water. Heat just to boiling. Sterilize by autoclaving at 15								
lbs pressure (121°C) for 15 minutes. Mix well and pour into sterile Petri plates. Note: Due to								
presence of calcium carbonate, the prepared medium forms opalescent solution with white								
precipitate.								
Principle:								
Yeast extract serves as a good source of readily available amino acids, contain vitamin B complex								
and accessory growth factors for Rhizobia. It also poises oxidation – reduction potential of								
medium in the range favourable for Rhizobia and serves as hydrogen donor in respiratory process.								
Mannitol is the fermentable sugar alcohol source. Calcium and magnesium provide cations								
essential for the growth of Rhizobia. Agar is the solidifying agent.
